

POLICE COURT. (Before Mr. Pater, S.M.)

JUNE 1.

Harry, an aboriginal, charged with stealing a quantity of beer from the Terminus Hotel, pleaded guilty. He elected to be dealt with summarily, and was sentenced to 14 days' imprisonment.

Kum Sing, on remand, charged with the larceny of a cheque. On the application of Corporal Waters the prisoner was further remanded till the 11th June. Prisoner's bail was extended and he was berated.

JUNE 4.

Joe Flick, charged with escaping from custody in Queensland, was further remanded for seven days. It was arranged to have prisoner brought before a magistrate at the gaol, and have him remanded from thence.

JUNE 5.

Seraphim Alexander, charged with giving whiskey to a native named Nellie, pleaded guilty and was fined £3, with the promise of £10 on the next occasion. Defendant was allowed one week to get the cash.

Nellie, an aboriginal woman, for being drunk was locked up till 4 o'clock.
